## SPECIAL BUS SERVICES

### SERVICE FROM ANCHOR ROAD BY COACH TO WESTON

On certain days, as shown in the time table, arrangements have been made for special coaches to leave Anchor Road, Bristol, in connection with steamship sailings from Weston-super-Mare to Ilfracombe and elsewhere. On these occasions, the coaches proceed to Birnbeck Pier from where the steamers sail and meet the steamer on return at Birnbeck Pier in the evening in order to convey passengers on the return journey to Bristol.

On certain further occasions, the steamer sails from Bristol in the morning, but terminates the return journey at Weston. On these days, special coaches will be waiting at Birnbeck Pier to convey passengers to Bristol. As a result, a very much earlier return to Bristol at night is possible than would be the case, for tidal reasons, if the steamer made the journey to Bristol. The occasions when these services operate are set out in the time-table.

In every instance, when coach connections between Bristol and Weston operate, the coaches are specially reserved for steamer passengers and connect with the steamer on its forward and return journey at Birnbeck Pier at Weston.

It is not necessary to book in advance, but passengers may do so if they desire.

On occasions as shown in the time table, coaches operate via Clevedon in place of Weston.

On these occasions, the coaches proceed to Birnbeck Pier from where the steamers sail and meet the steamer on return at Birnbeck Pier in the evening in order to convey passengers on the return journey to Bristol.

On certain further occasions, the steamer sails from Bristol in the morning, but terminates the return journey at Weston. On these days, special coaches will be waiting at Birnbeck Pier to convey passengers to Bristol. As a result, a very much earlier return to Bristol at night is possible than would be the case, for tidal reasons, if the steamer made the journey to Bristol. The occasions when these services operate are set out in the time-table.

In every instance, when coach connections between Bristol and Weston operate, the coaches are specially reserved for steamer passengers and connect with the steamer on its forward and return journey at Birnbeck Pier at Weston.

It is not necessary to book in advance, but passengers may do so if they desire.

On occasions as shown in the time table, coaches operate via Clevedon in place of Weston.

DAY TRIPS BY BUS TO BARRY RETURNING TO WESTON-SUPER-MARE by steamer then by Bus or Rail to BRISTOL. Passengers may return from Barry by steamer, return from Barry to Weston by steamer, and com-

plete the remainder of the journey from Weston to Bristol by any normal service bus. The days when this service applies are shown under the sailings. Passengers wishing to travel by this route should purchase a normal day return steamer ticket to Barry and on the steamer between Barry and Weston and exchange the return half for a bus ticket from Weston to Bristol. Alternatively passengers may, if they prefer, exchange their steamer tickets for railway tickets aboard the steamer from Barry to Weston, and travel by train from Weston to Bristol.

CIRCULAR BOOKINGS BETWEEN BRISTOL, CLEVEDON AND WESTON—out by steamer, back by bus or vice versa. Full details of this arrangement are given under the special heading, "Fares and Conditions".

COMBINED STEAMER AND COACH TOURS. On certain days advertised overhead, passengers may make a combined Coach and Steamer Tour via Barry to Cardiff or to Porthawl, the Welsh Mountains or the Wye Valley.

In the case of trips to Porthawl, passengers travel through the beautiful vale of Glamorgan. On certain occasions they are shown to Barry then by steamer to Bristol—on others from Porthawl Harbour direct by steamer to Bristol.

When visiting the Welsh Mountains the coaches on leaving Cardiff or Barry travel via Pontypridd, Porth, Rhigos Mountain, the Vale of Neath, and Bridgend.

These tours provide an opportunity to see some of the most beautiful scenery in Wales—with, in the case of the Porthawl trip, many hours at one of the finest seaside resorts in the Principality.

Details of Coach Tours via Minehead or Ilfracombe are given under the appropriate days in the time table.

## RAIL FACILITIES

RAIL FACILITIES FROM BRISTOL DISTRICTS TO BARRY, ILFRACOMBE AND ELSEWHERE (via WESTON). There is an extensive service of steamers from Weston to Ilfracombe, Barry, Lynnouth and elsewhere. Special arrangements have been made with British Railways to enable passengers from the Bristol District to take advantage of this service. A through ticket from certain Bristol Stations to the various resorts

can be obtained from the Railway Booking Offices. These tickets enable passengers to travel to Weston by rail (2nd Class) and on from Weston by steamer. The return journey as far as Weston is made by steamer. Passengers return from Weston to Bristol by rail. The combined fares for this service from Bristol are the same as the steamer fare from Bristol to the destination in question.

## FARES AND CONDITIONS

TICKETS can be obtained on board the steamers or in advance at the Company's Offices. All tickets are issued and passengers carried subject to the Company's conditions of carriage as exhibited on Piers, at the Company's Offices, Agencies, and on their steamers. Sailings are subject to weather and circumstances.

Coach travel, where applicable between Bristol and Weston, or Bristol and Clevedon is included in the fares.

Clevedon or Weston passengers can return to Penarth, Weston, Temple Meads, Stapleton Hill or Stapleton Road Stations. Cardiff and Barry passengers return to Stapleton Road or Temple Meads Stations. \*Circular must be asked for when booked. If desired passengers may return by Steamer instead of Rail. Circular tickets are also issued from Temple Meads Station, outward by train and return by steamer, when sailings permit. There is no train service to and from Clevedon on Sundays.

\* CIRCULAR TRIPS by BUS to or from CLEVEDON and WESTON. By arrangement with the Bristol Omnibus Co. Ltd., passengers may return from either place to Bristol by bus, by tendering the return half of their steamer ticket to the conductor (without further charge). Passengers holding return halves of bus tickets from Bristol to Clevedon or Weston may return by

steamer to Bristol, on payment of an excess fare of 3/- at the Booking Office at Birnbeck Pier, Weston, or 6d. at the Toll House, Clevedon Pier (on day of issue).

PIER TOLLS are now included in the fares, except at Penarth 3d. (unless bus to and from Penarth). Passengers returning to Bristol on Saturdays commencing any date suitable to the Purchaser. Weekly tickets available anywhere in the Bristol District, other than on Saturdays, are now obtainable from any of the Company's Offices. The tickets are not transferable, and full details can be had on application.

Passengers are not to be carried on the following: (1) Bicycles, Tandems and Non-Folding Frms (at owners risk); 7/6d. single journey. A reasonable quantity of luggage (which must be labelled) is carried at Passenger's own risk. Bicycles cannot be landed at Lynn
